We will hold formal meetings with you about your child's EHCP review, through termly progress meetings annual reports, Family Support Worker.

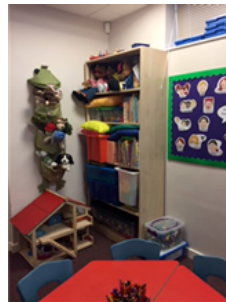
