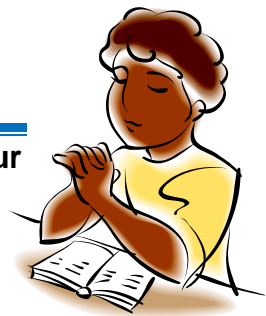

# Attendance:

At St. Anne Line Catholic Infant School we value good school attendance! Regular attendance supports your child in making good progress and achieving across the curriculum. Taking your child out of school during term time will be detrimental to your child's educational progress. A pupil who takes 10 days absence will only attain 94.7% attendance in a year. 10 days absence also means the pupil will miss 50 hours of education! Please remember there is no entitlement to parents to take their child out of school during term time.

**CURRENT WHOLE SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IS STEADY AT 96.8%. THIS CONTINUES TO BE GOOD BUT WE CAN DO BETTER WITH YOUR HELP IF YOU COME TO SCHOOL EVERY DAY, AND ON TIME!**

Any requests for leave of absence must be submitted on the appropriate form and with plenty of notice to the school. Please note letters 'informing' the school that children will not be attending for a period, without receiving the Headteacher's permission, will automatically receive an unauthorised absence.

Dear Mrs Russell,

Following my conversation with Mrs Greenwood of the 23/06/2017, could you, please, remind the parents and carers of your pupils that it is neither legal nor conducive of good relations with neighbours to leave their engine on while waiting for their charges to finish school.

Sometimes this waiting time can last for 20 minutes or more and today I had three cars discharging poisoning fumes in my sitting room 5 metres away from the exhausts. This behaviour is completely unacceptable.

On occasion, when I have politely asked for the engine to be switched off, a few have argued with me. They seemed completely unaware that it is illegal. Further they were unconcerned for the health implications for us all including the children, or the damage this does to the environment.

Could you, please, regularly make these issues known to those collecting children by car, by all means of communication at your disposal.
